To date over 3700 people have signed a petition against the Outrigger proposal for our public foreshore and *an incredible 1200 plus* have actually lodged letters of objection.

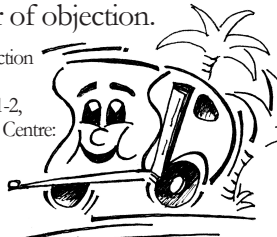
This is by far the Whitsunday's biggest ever public protest! What has galvanised the community in this unprecedented way?
