

Will our council now honour their own umpire's decision?

- The issue is absolutely clear. Based on the Queensland Government's recommendation, the Whitsunday Shire Council, last June, appointed an Independent Assessor to consider the Development Application for the FKP/Outrigger. Council's decision to do this was unanimous.
- The Development Application proposes a private multi-story hotel and gaming club on public foreshore land which is zoned for park and recreational use.
- The Queensland Government made the

recommendation after the council had received some 3,000 letters from the local community, objecting to the project.

- The Independent Assessors have now made their decision, based firmly on Town Planning and State Planning Policy criteria. Refuse the DA they say! Unequivocally!
- To keep any credibility with the community, council must now act in the public interest and refuse this application. The 'umpire's decision' should be final!
