Save Our Foreshore has reason to believe that council may decide to approve the FKP/Outrigger Development Application with minor cosmetic changes some time soon.

This is in spite of the fact that council's own Independent Assessor clearly recommended a total refusal of the application.

If we are to stop this happening it is essential that everybody in the community who wants their public foreshore protected starts to act NOW!

AWARE. You need to make yourself aware of exactly what is happening and just how much support several of our councillors, our State Member and our State Government seem to have for this inappropriate project on our public foreshore.

□ Our State Member has shown no support for SOF's position which has been clear all along and now independently confirmed as being correct. She has written to SOF stating "I could not possibly adopt a populist, politically convenient position when my

knowledge of the issues leads me to believe that position to be neither balanced nor fair".

ANGRY. Then you need to get angry. Several members of our council may be planning to ignore their own Assessors advice and that in itself should be enough to get you boiling mad.

ACTIVE. And then you need to take that anger and use it to get yourself active.

Let these councillors know what you think of their attitude to our public foreshore. Tell everyone you meet that they need to get active too. NOW. Join SOF or at least visit our caravan at the Saturday markets and offer some help, even if it's just handing out leaflets!

The only way we're going to win this is if we let council and government know that they ignore community wishes at their peril. And that means we need to be seen and heard. All of us. Otherwise they'll go about their business without giving us a second thought.
