

YOU CAN SAVE OUR PUBLIC FORESHORE MR BEATTIE...

Whatever decision the Council makes on the FKP proposal for Airlie Beach's public foreshore, Mr Beattie can stop it happening.

This is State land and his government has the power to reject the lease.

The Whitsundays community has made it clear that they do not want this multi-storey apartment hotel with its gaming venue and liquor sales. Certainly not on public foreshore zoned as open space and certainly not right next to the lagoon their families use.

Over three thousand have already signed letters of objection to the proposal!



Even the Independent Assessor, appointed by the Whitsunday Council on Mr Beattie's Minister's advice, recommended refusal of the development based on a raft of town planning and flood study evidence.

The Council, it appears, will most likely ignore their community and that leaves it up to Mr Beattie.

Will he be "Standing Up for Whitsunday" or will it be the developers? In this case he can't do both!
