want to make sure this development goes ahead in spite of all this. Hence the ongoing delays.

The community has shown its rejection of this proposal with over 3,000 letters of objection and a petition of over 5,000 signatures. Even council's own Assessors have shown their total rejection. It's time that council got the message.
